Regional Ambulance Bus

Putnam County EMS has been asked to house a regional ambulance bus. Putnam County has been the hub of the Upper Cumberland for disaster preparedness and other activities for many years. Each of the states 8 regions have a similar bus or are in the process of acquiring one. State of Tennessee, EMS purchased litter kits for each region a few years ago. The Upper Cumberland has a bus located in Smith County. That bus is no longer suitable for use. This would be a joint effort by the 14 Upper Cumberland Counties, Upper Cumberland EMS Director's Association, State of Tennessee EMS and Upper Cumberland Health Care Coalition.


The purpose of this bus is to be a regional ambulance bus. It would be capable of carrying 10-12 stretcher patients in case of a mass evacuation of a nursing home or hospital. It could also be suitable for rehabilitation on large fire scenes. It would be primarily for the Upper Cumberland Area. It would be a disaster-use bus, not for daily use.

Putnam County will be responsible to house, and do routine maintenance on the bus. Upper Cumberland Healthcare Coalition will retrofit the bus as an ambulance including litter racks, air conditioning, generator, etc. Upper Cumberland EMS Directors will also support the project, as necessary.

Putnam County EMS has been offered a surplus school bus by Cumberland County. There were no suitable surplus buses available from Putnam County this year.

Whereas, Putnam County has agreed to insure and house the vehicle with maintenance costs shared with Director's Association and the Healthcare Coalition, and




Whereas, the fair market value of the bus is estimated at \$1,500.00.

Please accept this letter as an official lease agreement between Boswell's Harley-Davidson and Putnam County for two 2017's FLHTP Harley-Davidson motorcycle's with the following terms:

1. Lease is for a period of two years beginning (Pending) October 1, 2016 and ending on September 30, 2018.
2. The first payment for the first year of the lease totaling \$6,798.96 (283.29 per motorcycle per month) will be paid prior to the beginning of the lease. The second year's lease payment for the same amount will be paid on or before September 30 2017.
3. Putnam County will be responsible for the cost of purchasing or transferring emergency equipment and paying for the installation (labor) on the 2017 models.
4. Putnam County will be responsible for transferring the emergency equipment from the 2017 motorcycles to any future model motorcycle.
