

SENATE BILL NO. 3743

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 16, Chapter 20, Part 1, relative to litigation taxes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 16-20-106, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

(g)(1) By a two-thirds (2/3) vote of its legislative body, each county to which subdivision (c)(1) or (d) is applicable is authorized to levy an additional (\$1.00) litigation tax, for a total of two dollars (\$2.00) per case, to be denominated as a part of the court costs for each petition, warrant and citation, including warrants and citations for traffic offenses, in matters before the local general sessions courts and juvenile courts.

(2) Any revenue generated by subdivision (g)(1) shall be used by the county for the exclusive purpose of supporting a local victim-offender mediation center or centers organized pursuant to this chapter. Such funds shall be distributed on a monthly basis by the county to the victim-offender mediation center or centers for the purpose of handling victim-offender mediation and other community mediation matters.


(3) The taxes levied pursuant to this subsection (g) shall be in addition to any other taxes levied on litigation.

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any provision of this act to the contrary, any fees increased by this act that are assessed against the state or that otherwise represent a cost to the state shall be limited to the amounts chargeable prior to January 1, 2012.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.

MEDIATION SERVICES of PUTNAM COUNTY, Inc.

What is MEDIATION? Mediation is the involvement of an impartial or trusted third party to help people resolve their disputes/conflicts. Mediation provides a peaceful alternative to taking out a warrant and going through the judicial process or letting conflicts escalate at home, school, work, or in the community. The mediation process empowers participants to resolve the situation themselves. The process and resulting contracts emphasize responsibility, accountability, future choices, and healing.

Mediation services are provided to juveniles aged 8 to 17 and adults at no cost per Tennessee law. Services are voluntary. people choose to participate. In 2011 services were provided to more than 300 people, 147 of them new and the remaining who have open case contracts.

SERVICES:

Court Intake
Mediation – court & community
Shoplifting Intervention Course (juveniles)
Mediator Training
Referral to other resources/services
Community Education/Training

Other Service Activities include case management, client & volunteer contact and correspondence, mediation scheduling, volunteer recruitment and supervision, and contract monitoring including collecting and paying out restitution.

Of the cases closed since services began in 1993 through 2011: 4,978 new people were served (about 200 more receive contract services each year), \$96,959.17 in restitution was collected and paid out, 5,200 hours of community or family service were completed, 91.33% of mediations resulted in contract, and 95% of the cases closed contracts were completed successfully.

Participant comments include: " *It's a great program – thank you*", " *This is a better way to solve any conflict*", " *Everything has worked out – I am pleased*", " *Thanks to Mediation Services*", " *Our mediators were very understanding and really seemed to care*", " *(mediation) gave me a chance to see the other person's perspective and see how this problem affected her life*", " *I think mediation is a wonderful program for these situations*".

BENEFITS:

MEDIATION IS: fast, confidential, safe, cooperative, cost effective, and successful.

MEDIATION INCREASES: the peaceful resolution of conflicts in our communities, voice for victims, accountability for offenders, contract/restitution fulfillment, and participant satisfaction.

MEDIATION DECREASES: the number of cases in our court systems, repeat offenses, fear and violence.

Mediation helps our communities be more peaceful and productive and provides many benefits including: **Individuals** (co-workers, neighbors, school mates, family members, etc.) can maintain or restore relationships, are empowered to make the decisions, are more satisfied with the process thus more likely to successfully comply with the agreement they reached, and are more likely to use these communication and conflict resolution skills in future situations. People are more productive when issues are resolved rather than lingering and not missing work or school to address problems in court. **Juveniles** learn skills that they can use for life and how to make better choices, take responsibility for their actions, and are less likely to be caught up in the justice system. *These individual benefits also impact community systems.*

Schools can focus on education instead of absences or disruptions caused by conflicts and promote skill building that enhances safe schools.

Workplace - Employees & employers can be at work focusing on their job responsibilities instead of missing work due to court and/or injury, both of which are distracting. They can help provide a positive atmosphere to the workplace.

The **Community** becomes a more peaceful place with more productive citizens and less violence and crime. The use of mediation gives more time for courts and related staff to focus on those more serious cases that need to be addressed in court.

Why I Volunteer

The court system can often be harshly impersonal in its application of laws. Mediation certainly does not ignore or minimize violations of the law, but it may allow the justice system to be tempered with humanity.

During most of my time as a volunteer, I have worked in General Sessions Court on Monday mornings interviewing potential candidates for mediation. Many such candidates are in court for the first time and are frightened and bewildered by the judicial process. Their first reaction when I begin to describe the mediation alternative may be suspicion. Frequently, however, this suspicion turns to relief and gratitude when I explain that, in suitable cases, mediation allows both parties to discuss issues out of court and perhaps arrive at a settlement without assigning blame.

As a volunteer I appreciate being the first contact that most clients have with mediation services. The intake interview provides an opportunity to bring potentially good news to people in troubling circumstances. In this initial contact I can perhaps begin to dispel anger, alleviate some fears, and demonstrate an important truth—that polite discussion can be an effective way of solving some of the many disputes that plague society today.

Recently, a friend of mine asked me why I was a volunteer mediator. My friend's question gave me an opportunity to examine why I did choose to be a volunteer mediator. I knew that I enjoyed the experience. However, until the question was asked, I never examined the reasons behind my choice.

I discovered three reasons why I volunteer to be a mediator. The first reason is that I like and respect the people with whom I work. The second reason is that it provides an opportunity for me to make a difference. The third reason is that it gives me a better understanding of others and myself.

I have found my fellow mediators (and I include Linda Mix, the Director of Mediation Services as a fellow mediator and my mentor) to be people of integrity and makers of peace. I learn something new from them each mediation. I enjoy being part of a team with my fellow mediators. I find them to be very supportive.

Is there a better way to spend your time than to help people resolve a conflict or a dispute? I found that I can part of a process that helps people resolve conflict. With each mediation, I have an opportunity to make a difference – to be a maker of peace. Sometimes, even magic happens!

With each mediation I gain a better understanding of others and myself. I have a better understanding of my own strengths and weaknesses. I have a better insight into my own behavior and my own beliefs. I also gain a better understanding of others. I have a better understanding, acceptance, awareness and respect for others and the events in their lives.

To encourage you to become a volunteer for Mediation Services, I offer you the following. Recently for Black History Month, at Tennessee Tech, I heard a lecture by b.f. maiz, a poet. He challenged us by saying that Cain asked God a question. Are we our brother's keeper? b.f. maiz told us that we as people of privilege could only answer that question with a resounding yes!

Please give back to your community and become a healer and a maker of peace.



DEPUTY TREVOR BARRETT


